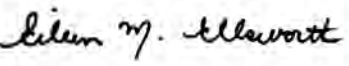
Many people feel a deep connection to work that helps build a more resilient and welcoming community. Neighbors who give and neighbors who receive all have a home with us.

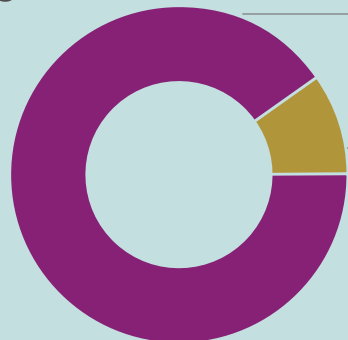

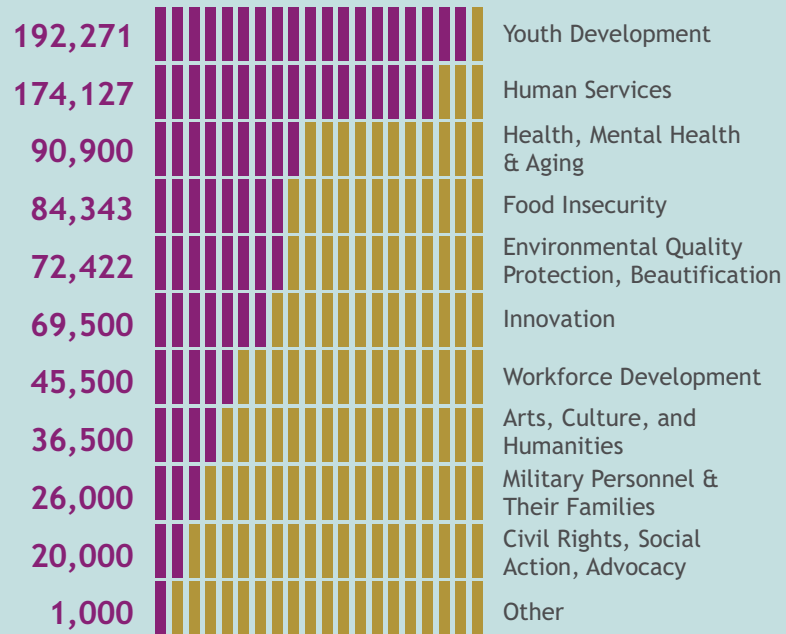

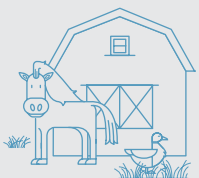

## COUNT THE REGION

*A “get out the count” initiative for the 2020 Decennial Census at the Community Foundation for Northern Virginia*

This year, we launched “Count the Region” to help get out the count for the 2020 Census in Northern Virginia, making sure everyone living in Northern Virginia is counted, counted once, and counted in the right place.

The importance of the 2020 Census cannot be overstated. For every Virginia who is not counted, the region loses \$1,200 per year for 10 years, or \$12,000 total, in federal assistance program allocations.

The event served as a platform to discuss economic mobility, income inequality, and increased opportunity for our region.

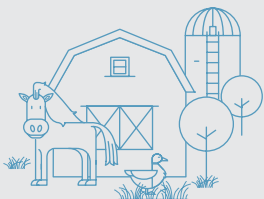

The Community Foundation for Northern Virginia awarded more than \$5.4 million in grants and scholarships during our fiscal year that ended June 30, 2019, including \$812,563 in grants from discretionary grant funds and from donor advised funds that the Community Foundation directly brokered to help respond to need and seed innovation in Northern Virginia.

## **Child and Youth Development Fund**

*Helps children and youth to thrive*

### **Arlington Arts Center\*\*, \$6,500**

*Serving Arlington County*

Funding supported two programs serving at-risk youth: an after-school art enrichment program at Carlin Springs Elementary, a Title 1 school, and a program for preschoolers, offered in conjunction with Bridges to Independence, a local non-profit serving homeless families.

### **Bowen McCauley Dance Center\*\*, \$10,000**

*Serving Arlington County*

Funding supported school dance programs serving diverse, low-income students in Northern Virginia and an annual MOVE ME Festival.

### **Communities in Schools of NOVA, \$10,000**

*Serving Alexandria*

Funding supported academic improvement, family engagement, and career college readiness supports.

### **Fairfax County Park Foundation, \$10,000**

*Serving Fairfax County*

Funding provided general support to FCPF to cover salaries for 8 staff counselors and directors for the PACT program.

### Girls on the Run of NOVA\*\*\*, \$10,000

Serving Fairfax County

Funding supported program expansion and access to the GOTR program to girls along the Richmond Highway Corridor.

### Higher Achievement\*\*\*, \$10,000

Serving Alexandria

Funds supported Higher Achievement's year-round out-of-school time program in Alexandria which supports academic achievement and social-emotional growth of students in grades 5 - 8.

### Hispanics Against Child Abuse and Neglect\*\*\*, \$10,000

Serving Fairfax County

Funds supported the implementation of the LEER+ program which supports literacy growth and makes sure families are thriving through establishing a relationship of trust and support.

### INMED Partnerships for Children, \$10,000

Serving Loudoun County

Funding supported INMED's academically-focused after-school program for at-risk children.

### Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation, Inc.\*, \$6,000

Serving Prince William County

This grant enabled approximately 600 under-served elementary school students from Manassas City public schools to participate in the Virginia Outreach Education program.

### Liberty's Promise, \$10,000

Serving All of Northern Virginia

The grant enabled 150 low-income, immigrant youth to learn about American civic life in Northern Virginia as well as acquire job skills and college-access training through their after-school programs of civic engagement.

### Music for Life\*\*, \$10,000

Serving Fairfax County

Funding helped provide music education programs to 60 low income students at Mount Vernon High School in Fairfax County during the 2019-2020 school year (20 students each in three programs.)

### National Inventors Hall of Fame\*, \$10,000

Serving Prince William County

This grant engaged 45 Prince William County underserved youth, grades K-6, in Camp Invention – a high-quality STEM enrichment program that builds critical thinking, self-confidence, entrepreneurship, collaboration, and other 21st century skills.

### Northern Virginia Family Service\*\*\*, \$10,000

Serving Fairfax County

Funding allowed NVFS to conduct twelve, week-long School Specific Groups for at least 30 recently immigrated youth at Francis C. Middle School and West Potomac High School who needed support facilitating a healthy transition to their new community.

### Rosie Riveters\*\*\*, \$7,788

Serving Fairfax County

This grant supported a 6 week intensive Summer STEM program followed by a ten-month after-school program for 12-14 girls in 3rd-5th grade at the Gum Springs Community Center.

### The House\*, \$10,000

Serving Prince William County

This grant supported The House Student Leadership Center's afterschool EmpowerMEnt® initiative through program support for 300 youth through leadership development, training, mentoring, and co-curricular elective opportunities.

### The Josh Anderson Foundation\*\*\*, \$6,575

Serving Alexandria

Funding supported the second-year operations of the Our Minds Matter after-school clubs at Mount Vernon, West Potomac and Edison High Schools.

## Education Fund

*Helps increase the number of children and adults who are prepared to enter a competitive workforce in the 21st century*

### BEACON for Adult Literacy\*, \$10,000

*Serving Manassas/Manassas Park*

Funding provided general support for comprehensive programming to low-income adult immigrants striving for English language proficiency, employment, self-sufficiency, and family stability.

### Edu-Futuro (Educacion Para Nuestro Futuro), \$10,000

*Serving Fairfax County*

The grant supported the Emerging Leaders Program which enhances the leadership abilities of low-income youth from Latino and immigrant backgrounds.

### Falls Church-McLean Children's Center, \$10,000

*Serving Fairfax County*

This grant provided an effective, early education program for young children to overcome the skills gap that results from growing up in poverty, from having parents with limited English skills, or from developmental delays that are interfering with their ability to learn.

### Loudoun Literacy Council, \$10,000

*Serving Loudoun County*

This grant provided general support funding for programs and operations to promote literacy in Loudoun County.

### Main Street Child Development Center, \$10,000

*Serving Fairfax County*

Funding supported Main Street's preschool program, particularly to provide mental health, behavioral, and special needs services to students and provide teachers with the necessary resources and training to be successful.

### OAR of Fairfax, \$10,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

Funding supported OAR's Work Empowerment Program for criminal justice involved adults in Fairfax, Prince William, and Loudoun Counties.

### The Center for Alexandria's Children, Inc.\*\*\*, \$10,000

*Serving Alexandria*

Funding supported Learn & PlayGroups™ which are designed for vulnerable, isolated families of children 0-5 who lack access to quality, affordable early childhood and parenting programs.



### The Child and Family Network Centers\*\*\*, \$10,000

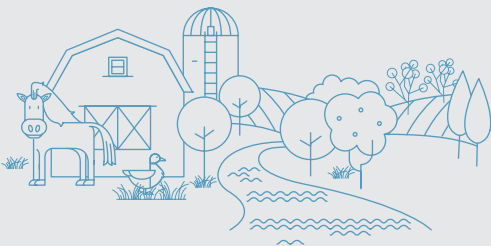
*Serving Alexandria*

Funding helped CFNC prepare 138 at-risk, four-year old children and immigrant families to thrive in kindergarten; reduce language, health, social-emotional, and socioeconomic barriers to learning; and empower parents to advocate for their long-term success in school and in life.

### The Literacy Lab\*\*\*, \$4,637

*Serving Alexandria*

This grant helped The Literacy Lab create a literacy safety net that ensures disadvantaged English Language Learners in grades K-3 in Alexandria have access to the reading support they need.



## Health, Mental Health and Aging Fund

*Supports programs that serve Northern Virginia's elderly populations, particularly those who are low income or vulnerable*

### PRS, Inc., \$19,925

*Serving Fairfax County*

This grant provided funding to PRS CrisisLink CareRing, through which phone calls are provided to clients for social support while also assessing risk for depression, suicide and cognitive decline through scheduled contacts either daily or several times throughout the week.

### Rebuilding Together Arlington/Fairfax/Falls Church, Inc., \$19,925

*Serving Fairfax County*

This grant supported the Rebuilding Together Express (RT Express) program to help more low-income homeowners age in place safely and comfortably by providing small teams of 4-5 skilled volunteers to complete half-day projects throughout the year to deliver targeted repairs.

## Military Personnel & Their Families Fund

*Supports the needs of military personnel and their families*

### Easter Seals Greater Washington-Baltimore Region, \$13,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

Funding supported the Easterseals Veteran Staffing Network: Securing Fulfilling Careers for Veterans and Military Spouses.

### Melwood Horticultural Training Center, Inc., \$13,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

This grant provided funding for Melwood's Vets Ready2Work Program. The program provides workforce development and vocational support services for veterans in Northern Virginia in need of employment.

## Poverty Relief Fund

*Supports programs that provide assistance to people affected by poverty, including food, shelter, eviction/foreclosure prevention and other emergency assistance*

### Arlington Thrive, \$5,047

*Serving Arlington County*

The grant supported the Daily Emergency Financial Assistance Program. All funds will be used to provide same-day emergency assistance to prevent eviction, homelessness, and other catastrophes for an additional 60 Arlington County households who are facing a short-term crisis.

### Britepaths, \$10,000

*Serving Fairfax County*

Funding supported Britepaths' Financial Assistance Program which provides emergency rent, utility, pharmaceutical, and car repair assistance to low and middle-income clients.

### Doorways for Women and Families, \$10,000

*Serving Arlington County*

This grant supported families experiencing homelessness through emergency shelter and comprehensive support services at the Family Home in Arlington.

### Friends of Guest House, Inc., \$10,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

This grant supported general operating funds to support prison-to-community reentry services tailored to women's unique needs.

### Friends of Loudoun Mental Health, \$10,000

*Serving Loudoun County*

Funding supported Loudoun County residents who have a serious mental illness with housing subsidies to provide safe, stable and affordable housing.

### Habitat for Humanity Prince William County\*, \$10,000

*Serving Manassas/Manassas Park*

Funding supported the Neighborhood Revitalization program in the East End Mobile Home Park in the City of Manassas.

### Mobile Hope, \$10,000

*Serving Loudoun County*

This grant supported the emergency lodging needs of our Homeless Youth Emergency Support program.

### Offender Aid and Restoration of Arlington, Inc., \$10,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

The grant provided housing assistance to individuals who are returning home to Arlington County and the Cities of Alexandria and Falls Church after incarceration.

### Project Mend-a-House\*, \$10,000

*Serving Prince William County*

Funding supported continued home repair services to the vulnerable population living in Prince William County and Greater Manassas areas. Repair services will include accessibility, modification, plumbing, electrical & other home repair need.

### Rebuilding Together Alexandria, \$10,000

*Serving Alexandria*

Funds helped provide assistance to people affected by poverty through support of the Alexandria-based Safe and Healthy Homes program.

### Tahirih Justice Center, \$10,000

*Serving All of Northern Virginia*

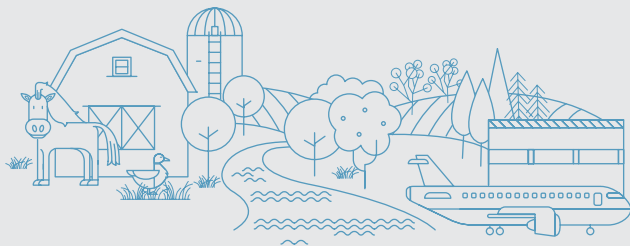
Funding supported programs that protect immigrant women and girls in Northern Virginia who are fleeing gender-based violence.

### FACETS^, \$6,445

*Serving Fairfax County*

This annual grant is made possible by the Huntsman Endowment Fund and supports FACETS' operating budget to help parents, their children and individuals who suffer the effects of poverty in Fairfax County.



## HEALTHY KIDS GRANTS

*Supports efforts made by public schools in Northern Virginia to improve activity level and nutrition throughout the region in collaboration with the Chin Family Charitable Fund and the J.O.Y. Charitable Fund*

### **Arlington Career Center - Kick Asana: Teen Yoga and Mindfulness, \$2,000**

*Arlington County*

This project increased physical activity for high school students with vigorous yoga, assessed effectiveness of mindfulness practices on stress, and created videos with the TV Production and Culinary Arts programs to teach middle school students healthy exercise, eating and mindfulness habits.

### **Bailey's Primary Elementary School - Bailey's Biking for Fitness, \$2,000**

*Fairfax County*

Funding supported a school-based bicycle skills, safety, and fitness program through PE class, teaching students to learn how to ride a bike, stay safe while riding, and learn how to use bicycle riding as a means to stay fit and healthy for a lifetime.

### **Centreville Elementary School - Healthy Cooking from the Garden to the Table, \$1,440**

*Fairfax County*

This program supported healthy eating in the homes of approximately 500 students, grades K-6, by offering an after school cooking class for families & students. Children selected ingredients from the school gardens to create meals that they could eat.

### **Coles Elementary - WOW (Work Out Weekly) Club, \$2,000**

*Prince William County*

This project increased physical activity for 147 fourth and fifth grade students through daily core strengthening and cardiovascular exercises before students went to their homeroom classes, using an existing outdoor fitness trail as well as weights and resistance bands.

### **Falls Church High School - Wobble Work, \$2,000**

*City of Falls Church*

Funding provided wobble chairs for stations for students and teachers to promote better posture and building core muscles.

### **Goshen Post Elementary School - Jogging and Walking Superstars (JAWS), \$1,855**

*Loudoun County*

This project increased activity levels of about 250-300 students grades K-5 by offering a morning running club twice a week before school for twenty minutes.

### **Laurel Ridge Elementary School - Keepin' it Kinesthetic, \$2,000**

*Fairfax County*

This project built upon the success of the Pedaling for Progress Healthy Kids grant from last year by allowing students to be active while learning.

### **Lynbrook Elementary School - Food Day, \$2,000**

*Fairfax County*

Funding supported Food Day to build awareness of and inclination for healthy choices and to increase knowledge and change attitudes about foods and exercise among preschool and elementary school students.

### **Marshall Road Elementary School - Yoga for Students with Special Needs, \$2,000**

*Fairfax County*

This project brought yoga and mindfulness to students with special needs. Some of these students expanded upon the skills they learned in year one (also funded by a Healthy Kids grant) and all students gained skills to regulate their emotions and improve academic performance.

### **Saratoga Elementary School - Stallions (Re) Energized for Excellence, \$950**

*Fairfax County*

This project increased physical activity among 200-300 2nd through 6th grade students by continuing a before school walking/jogging club that was initially funded by a Healthy Kids grant in 2017. The club allows students to walk/jog prior to entering the classroom, which helps increase mental alertness and readiness for the school day.

### **Westfield High School - Girls' Only Fitness Class (GOFC) at Westfield HS (WHS), \$2,000**

*Fairfax County*

Funding supported the GOFC, an elective class offered to females only at WHS who are non-athletes, not in PE class and want to learn what healthy eating and good nutrition is, how to reduce their stress, what activities they can do for the rest of their lives to stay fit, how to defend themselves and stay safe from harm.



## INNOVATION FUND

*A source of venture philanthropy that invests in inventiveness, creativity and new design.*

### **PHILLIPS Programs for Children and Families, \$25,000**

*Serving all of Northern Virginia*

Funding helped PHILLIPS explore a social enterprise worker cooperative initiative, an urban indoor vertical farm that grows fresh produce based on a current vertical farm operation at one of its school programs.

### **Nova Labs+, \$7,000**

*Serving all of Northern Virginia*

This grant promoted and spurred innovation and creativity for the 5,000+ attendees at the annual Nova Maker Faire held at George Mason University's Fairfax campus in March 2019.

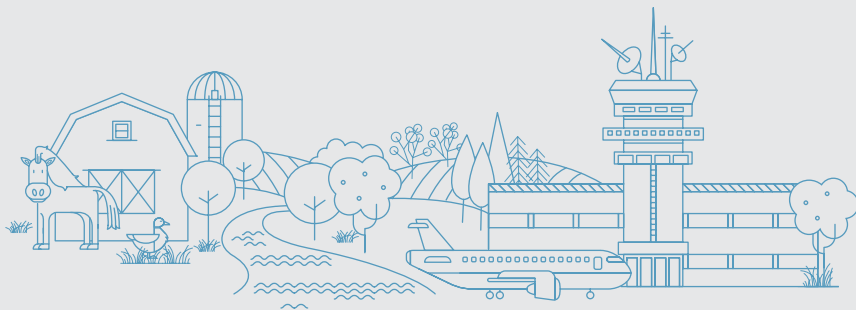
### **NoVA Outside^^, \$10,000**
